EAA CHAPTER 1300 YOUNG EAGLES RALLY -

EAA Chapter 1300 will host a Young Eagles rally at the Henderson Executive Airport on Saturday Feb. 7, 2009. Registration will be at the Mojave Aviation Open House on Jet Stream Dr. from 9:30 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. The EAA Young Eagles program provides an introduction to aviation including a free flight for kids from 8 to 17 years of age. EAA pilots around the world have volunteered their time and aircraft to fly over 1.4 million Young Eagles since the program began in 1992. Flights will be offered on a first come, first serve basis and will require a registration/release form signed by a parent or legal guardian. JEAN AIRPORT - The repairs to the Runways at the Jean Airport have been completed. Thank you for your cooperation during this time.

Please use caution when converging on the Las Vegas area from the South. With the increased activity at Henderson Executive we have had some instances where air traffic has passed very close to Jean enroute to the greater Las Vegas area. Please be cautious due to the intense skydiving activity 4 nautical miles south of Jean within a radius of 2 nautical miles of the jump center. In addition, there is intense glider activity within a 7 nautical mile radius of Jean Airport. We ask that you monitor Jean CTAF (122.9 MHZ) for current glider and skydiving activities.

TOWER TALK Greetings From The Tower

Hello folks.

In the event of an in-flight emergency, be advised HND does not have emergency equipment situated on the airport. The City of Henderson dispatches emergency equipment to the airport. It takes them 11-14 minutes to arrive at HND. If the nature of the emergency would allow, ATC will request concurrence from the pilot to remain airborne until emergency equipment arrives on the scene. The minimum information we need from the pilot is aircraft identification and type, nature of the emergency, and pilot's desires. In addition ATC will request number of persons on board and fuel remaining in time or pounds. If the pilot does not declare an emergency, ATC or officials responsible for the operations of the aircraft may declare an emergency.
