CREDIT CARD ON FILE - We are pleased to announce that we are again able to hold credit card information on file for payment of fuel, lease fees and other services. We were able to restore this service due to additional security features that have been built into our accounting system. To use this service, we ask that you complete a participation form available at the Customer Service counter. If you wish to pay your rent or other charges, any Customer Service Representative can complete this service during normal operating hours. If your account is current, we can put your card on file for future charges during our office hours, Monday-Friday 0800-1600.

REMINDER - Please keep in mind the use of airport premises is for the storage and maintenance of authorized aircraft and items related to the use of the tenant's authorized aircraft. No person shall use any open area of the airport for storage of non-aviation related property, including, but not limited to, cargo, non-airworthy aircraft, vehicles, motor vehicles, mobile equipment or other property without prior written permission of the Director, or designee.

CANINE CO-PILOT - Porsche is a five-year-old female Bouvier Des Flandres. She belongs to Biff Leonard, a Baron 58 pilot based at HND. While Porsche is considered to be part of the herding group, her breed is frequently employed as police dogs in Europe. The Bouvier is a loyal family dog and is Biff's personal companion, guard dog and co-pilot. Porsche has over 420 hours of multi-engine time in the Baron and a lesser amount of time in a Comanche 260B. She is a frequent visitor to the front desk and can be seen sitting in the shade of the hangars waiting for the pre-flight to be completed before she boards the aircraft.

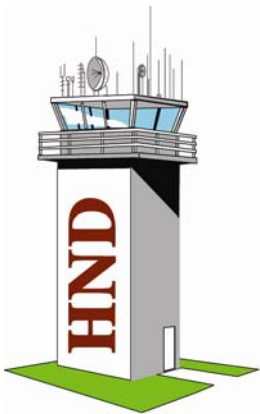
Greetings From The Tower

In order to increase the safe and expeditious movement of aircraft in the National Airspace System, please comply with the following:

When calling for taxi, inform GC of your position on the airfield and direction of flight i.e. SE, SW, staying in the pattern etc. Familiarize yourself with the airport, airport markings and LAS Class B airspace. Exit the runway at the first available taxiway that safety allows. Remain on LC frequency when holding between the runways. Readback runway of assignment e.g. "Cleared to land runway One Seven Right".
